Jongleurs Comedy Group Plc & Wilton Corporate Finance Limited

Wilton Corporate Finance Limited has been instructed by Jongleurs Comedy Limited to raise £2.5m in capital to rebuild the business.

Jongleurs started life in 1982 with one comedy show being shown in Battersea, London. By 2000 they had 6 clubs throughout the U.K and this extended to 16 clubs by 2009. This made Jongleurs by far the biggest comedy club chain in Europe and the 2nd biggest in the world.

In 2000 Regent Inns Plc bought the property side of the company and left the founders with a comedy booking and management agency. The terms of the deal where that Jongleurs Comedy Limited owned all the rights to Jongleurs other then the right to open and operate clubs. In 2009 Regent Inns went into administration and all of the rights pertaining to Jongleurs returned to Jongleurs Comedy Limited.

The funds being raised will be used to re-develop the club side of the business, this time the company will not only own venues but they will develop strategic partnerships with large pub and club chains. This will enable the company to grow at an incredible rate.

Jongleurs also intends to build a media business using the comedy content produced at the events to make television programs and a subscription based service.

Jongleurs will be raising Private Equity money prior to a proposed float on AIM in November 2010.
